Effective January 1, 2005 there is a new law that protects Sports Officials and Coaches.

Every person convicted of an offense shall be sentenced as provided. The court shall impose a minimum fine of \$1,000 for a first offense and \$2,000 for a second or subsequent upon a person convicted of or placed on supervision for battery when the individual harmed was a sports or coach at any level of competition and the act causing harm to the sports official or coach occurred within an athletic facility or within the immediate vicinity of the athletic facility at which the sports official or coach was an active participant of the athletic contest held at the athletic facility. Aggravated assault is a Class A misdemeanor.

Any offense committed against a referee or a coach by a coach, parent or athlete regardless of the criminal outcome, will be addressed by the Athletic Committee as to the appropriate disciplinary action to be taken. The penalty for the coach or athlete could include, but is not limited to, suspension or removal from the team. The penalty for the parent could include, but is not limited to, being barred from future games.
