Thank you for choosing St. Laurence Catholic School for your children for the 2012/2013 school year. We recognize that in order to provide a quality educational program sacrifices are required by our parents, parishioners, and staff members. The St. Laurence Education Commission has made every effort to keep fees and tuition at a reasonable rate.

Based on the projected enrollment, the cost to educate one student at St. Laurence is \$3,850.00. Tuition for one student in the fall is \$2800.00. St. Laurence Church, through the generosity of its parishioners, contributes the difference to the school budget. This also supplements the multi-student tuition discount. A tuition schedule is coming home with tuition and fees as they apply to your family. Discounts are offered for families with multiple children. The increase in tuition includes allotments for books and materials, professional staff development, upgrading technology and building and grounds needs.

- ✓ Registration - Wednesday, August 8 from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm - 7:30 pm
- ✓ The first day of school next year will be on Wednesday, August 22 - 11:30 dismissal
Uniforms will be worn on the 1st day
- ✓ Payment for Trifecta tickets is due at registration. Tickets are coming home today.
- ✓ State Health requirements are as follows:
 - Prekindergarten* - Physical exam
 - Kindergarten* - Physical, Dental & Eye exam
 - Grade 2* - Dental Exam
 - Grade 6* - Physical and Dental Exam
- NEW REQUIREMENT** for the 2012/2013 school year: all students entering the sixth grade will be required to provide proof of a dose of the whooping cough (Tdap) vaccination in addition to all the physical and immunization requirements for entry to the sixth grade.
- Please make appointments early as forms are due at August registration. All forms needed are coming home today and need to be filled out in entirety.
- ✓ All student athletes will need a current physical and proof of insurance to participate in any of the sport programs next school year per diocesan regulations.
- ✓ A supply list for next fall is coming home today and is available on the website.
- ✓ School uniforms can be purchased via phone or internet at Land's End School. An informational sheet is coming home today.
- ✓ Gym uniforms are purchased through the school. Order forms are available on our website or at the school office.
- ✓ If you're interested in your child attending After School Care next school year, please complete the form coming home today and return it promptly.
